



I Christian Croll being sick and weak in Body Yet of a sound & Perfect understanding and Memory do make this my last Will and Testament in manner Following Viz I Will that all my Debts and Funeral Expenses be paid and that my Wife Elizabeth Croll have the old House and Lot Situate on Northside of high Street in York Town until my son Mich. Marrys but when he Marrys She is to have two Rooms in the New House one Down Stairs the other up both at the Northside and at the End adjoining Andrew Nabingers Liberty of their Kitchen to wash and Cook in also of the Well and to put any Lumber or Grain on the Garret Loft and one half of the lot next Nabingers the Brendled Cow that is now in Town the Bay Mare bought of Cornelius Lane her bridle and Saddle the Bed and Bedding we used to lye on and her Choice of all the other Beds and one third Part of all the Furniture belonging to the House I Will to my son Philip the Plantation I bought of Jacob Heague Situate on the East of little Conewago with all the Improvements thereon and my Part of the Improvements and Land now in Partnership between George Stevenson Esq. and me also the mare I bought of Samuel Schultz Two Cows and two Breeding Sows A new Plow Share and Coulter Clevisses and Single Trees said Philip Yielding and paying to his Mother Yearly During her Widow Hood Sixty Seven Pounds of Pork thirty four Pounds of Beef Thirteen Bushels of Wheat Six Bushels of Rye and eight Bushels of Oats and to deliver her three Cords and a half of Firewood in Town I will to my Son Michael my two Houses and Lots in High Street in York Town Situate between Andrew Nabingers on the East and a House of Michael Swoopes on the West with all the appurtenances and Improvements there unto belonging and said Michael is to have all the Bedding and Beds in the House at the appraisement two only accepted for his Mother and one for his Sister Mary also my Gray Riding Horse Bridle and Saddle Said Michael is to find and Procure Sufficient Fodder for one Cow and one Horse and to give her annually and every Year During her Widow Sixty Seven pound of Pork and thirty four pounds of Beef. I Will to my Son John the Plantation I bought of George Allbright with all the appurtenances & Improvements thereon all the Iron Steels and Tools in the Smiths Shop The Roan Horse Two Cows six Sheep the Windmill Two Plows and the Irons belonging to them and four Breeding Sows and a Waggon and John is to give his Mother every Year During her Widow Hood Seventeen Bushels of Wheat Nine Bushels of Rye and twelve Bushels of Oats Sixty Seven Pounds of Pork and thirty four Pounds of Beef and to deliver her Six Cords and a half of Firewood every Year in Town I Will to my Son Henry the House and Lot wherein John Adlum lives and desire that the rents thereof be paid out to the Best advantage by my Executor for his use

I Will to my Daughter Mary my House and Lot in Water Street late the Estate Henry Schultz one Feather Bed and Bedding one Cow and four Sheep. I Will and Desire that my Patent Land on the West Side of Great Connewago and all my other Lands Houses and Lots not already mentioned be sold my Executors and that Barnet Candles and George Zin do serve their time with my Son John and that he teach or Cause them to be taught the Smith Trade and I constitute my Wife Elizabeth my Son Philip and Martin Eyklesberger the only and sole executors of this my last Will and Testament IN WITNESS whereof I have here unto Set my Hand and Seal the thirty first day of July 1758
