

Nicholas Craile/Krahl/Krehl

Searching for Nicholas Craile who served in the Revolutionary War from Cumberland Co., PA as a Captain in the Militia. He left PA and went west to Trumbull Co., OH with or without his wife Catharine Gordon, but with his 13 year old son, Samuel about 1812. Nicholas did come with his brother-in-law Rev. Wm Mathews and family. William served with the 8th Pennsylvania Regiment. His wife Rachel (Rebecca) d. 9 Apr 1827 at 72 years of age and is buried in the Kinsman Cemetery. There are no cemetery records of Nicholas Crail or William Mathews. They may have come from and possibly returned to Westmoreland Co., PA

RESEARCH

Michael Krehl – Strassburger & Hinke in *Pennsylvania German Pioneers* translated the name of a man who arrived at Philadelphia 1 Oct 1754 on the ship Phoenix. In List 222A his name is translated as Michael Grele and in list 222B as Michael Krahl.

- 1795 Nicholas Krehl purchased land at Cumberland Co., PA Southampton Twp. on 3 April from Conrad Beamer 1 N 44

- 1798 Catherine d/o Michael & Wilhelmina Krehl b. 3 Jul 1798 bpt. 2 Dec 1798 North Cumberland Co., PA, Jonestown
- Michael Krehl et al sells to Matthias Harter land in Greenwood Twp. 9 Aug 1799
- 1799, 25 Feb transaction on land tracts between Nicholas & Michael Krehl to Daniel Harman & George Bashore, recorded Sep 1811

- 1818 Krehl Michael d. 17 Nov 1818 in Harrisburg, Innkeeper for many years in Harrisburg – Cemetery and Necrology Records Jere Zeamer Records, Harrisburg, Dauphin Co. buried at the old Lutheran cemetery, later relocated to the present Harrisburg cemetery
- 1819 10 Jul recorded at Cumberland Co. Michael Krehl et all sell to Henry Bender land on 10 Jan 1816 in Rye Twp. Deed Book 1 EE p 154

3. Nicholas m. Catherine Gordon. Went to Kinsman, Trumbull Co., OH about 1810. His wife may or may not have gone with him. It is possible she died in PA before he traveled to Ohio. He did travel to Trumbull with his brother-in-law. Catherine may be the d/o Thomas W. Gordon who settled at Ashtabula Co., OH and sister to Rachael Gordon w/o Deacon William Mathews, early settler of Trumbull Co. Rachel and William Mathews are buried in Kinsman Presbyterian Cemetery. Catherine Gordon said to have a "Fire Lands or Sufferer's Land *1792) grant as compensation for colonist's losses in CT. This grant was said to have been used by Eli Krahl
